



RADAR INSTRUCTOR COURSE

The Department of Public Safety will be hosting a 32 hour, RADAR instructor course for all law enforcement agencies in Selma, AL at the ACJTC on Aug. 10 thru 13. Class size will be limited to 15 slots on a first come first served basis. Meals and lodging will be provided by the ACJTC. Price \$300.00.

This is a 32 hour course with the goal of improving your knowledge of RADAR speed measurement devices and gives you the instructional tools necessary to conduct a RADAR training program to other members of your agency.

You will learn the different scientific principles behind RADAR devices and their proper application within the overall speed enforcement program. In addition, we will cover the various aspects of equipment use such as testing and verification protocols, recertification considerations, case law, health issues, and other operational and policy considerations.

Through practical exercises using actual RADAR units, you will be exposed to the latest technology in the field. You will also take part in teaching exercises that emphasize the need for complete equipment familiarity on the part of the operator.

Topics include:

- Scientific principles of RADAR
- Operational considerations
- Case law and administrative rules
- Preparations for court presentation
- Theories of adult teaching and learning
- Four-step teaching process
- Practical exercises and written exams
- Classroom presentations

Each student will be required to score a minimum of 80% on the written exam and successfully complete the practical applications to receive certification.
